TASTING NOTES:

Rich and bold color, garnet-red – almost magenta. Expressive aromas of dark berries and blueberries with a wonderful layer of minerals. Full-bodied and quite dry, yet still comes across with juicy red currant flavors. Well-balanced and has a beautiful texture in the finish.

TASTING NOTES:

Across the palate, the wine is full-bodied and very well-polished. Refreshing blackberry flavors with silky smooth tannins. It has a very nice structure on the finish, well-balanced and long.

DESCRIPTION:

TASTING NOTES:

Dark violet with shimmering garnet tones. The aromas are very inviting with layers of ripe black cherry, boysenberry, and hints of tea leaf and wildflowers. The palate is rich and very complex with ripe black fruits, and crème de cassis. Velvety smooth and concentrated finish, along with a great texture and balance.

TASTING NOTES:

This 2021 'Bavarian Lion' Cabernet Sauvignon is deeply colored with some violet highlights. Complexed and well-layered aromas of blackberries, and cassis with notes of freshly crushed fruits. The palate is full and very expressive, offering dark berry flavors with a wonderful texture. The finish is firm, with ripe tannins, yet still sleek and elegant.
