DESCRIPTION:

Grand-Puy-Lacoste, one of Médoc's oldest estates, boasts a captivating history dating back to the 16th century. The name derives from "puy," indicating its elevated position resembling hillocks. It remained within a single-family line until 1920, before the Borie family took over in 1978. François-Xavier Borie, inheritor of the estate, ardently preserves its legacy. Raymond Dupin, another influential figure, greatly enhanced its renown. After World War I, financial strains led to the sale of the property. Jean-Eugène Borie, a dedicated winemaker, was pivotal in elevating Grand-Puy-Lacoste's stature alongside Château Ducru-Beaucaillou and Château Haut-Batailley.

TASTING NOTES:

"The 2019 Lacoste-Borie is a wine of immense charm. Wafting from the glass with aromas of cassis, licorice and sweet spices, loamy soil, and cigar wrapper, it's medium to full-bodied, fleshy and seamless, with ripe tannins, succulent acids, and a round, giving profile." – *Wine Advocate*

TASTING NOTES:

With Grenache taking center stage in this blend, this vintage presents intoxicating aromas and rich flavors. The 2019 Tempranillo, bold and textured, contributed just 7% to this year's blend, while a more significant portion of Mourvèdre was selected to enhance Grenache's finesse while adding structural support. The nose unfolds in layers, starting with cranberry and brambles, then evolving into notes of strawberry, cherry cola, and blackberry jam.

DESCRIPTION:

Nestled on the stony clay-flint terraces, locally known as “Graves de Saint-Émilion,” Château Grand Barrail Lamarzelle Figeac occupies a revered position stretching from Saint-Émilion village to Libourne and Pomerol. This estate has been cherished since antiquity and is recognized for producing exquisitely delicate and elegant wines. Château Grand Barrail Lamarzelle Figeac has earned its place among the elite Saint-Émilion Grand Cru wines, celebrated for its finesse and aromatic purity. Delicate tannins and meticulous aging enhance its balance, while the sand, gravel, and blue clay soil impart distinctive character. Adjacent to the renowned luxury hotel Grand Barrail, the vineyard’s picturesque setting welcomes visitors on the road to Saint-Émilion.

TASTING NOTES:

With its very deep ruby appearance, the 2018 vintage delivers power complex notes, where the intensity of violet aromas, typical of Cabernet franc grown on this terroir, dominates the bouquet and intermingles with red berry fruits. The wine is concentrated on the palate, supported by fine-grained tannins and savory mouthfeel.
