DESCRIPTION:

Immix is a personal project of Morgan Maureze and Nicole Seifert-Fink. Morgan started his career in his mid-teens, spending summers at Dominus Estate where he mostly worked in the vineyards. Upon achieving his degree in viticulture and enology from UC Davis, he decided to further pursue his education at the University of Bordeaux in an endeavor to compare both worlds. During his stay in France, he worked at Château Haut-Brion, Château Petrus, and Domaine de la Romanée Conti where he ultimately completed his Master's Thesis. Since returning to Napa Valley, he has been working with Andy Erickson, with whom he crossed paths at Ovid, assisting with his small high-end Napa Valley clients such as Arietta Wines, Dalla Valle Vineyards, Marciano Estate, and Screaming Eagle. He is currently the winemaker at Seven Apart Winery on the Silverado Trail.

TASTING NOTES:

Boasting deep dark (ruby) color. The wine opens up with powerful aromas of fresh blackberry, cassis, cola, coconut, flint, tropical wood, and spice box. On the palate, the wine is complex with a wonderful texture, greeting you with dense, silky tannins, and underlying flavors of vanilla bean, black cherry, and cacao that evolve over the beautifully elegant and lingering finish.

DESCRIPTION:

Red Car was founded in 2000 when Mark Estrin, Carroll Kemp, and Richard Crowell produced 50 cases of wine from a single ton of Syrah grapes in a Culver City garage. In a nod to their Los Angeles roots, the new venture was named Red Car after the trolley line that ferried riders across the region for the first half of the twentieth century.

In 2004, they purchased 125 acres of land and began developing vineyards in the wild coastal ridges north of Sonoma County's Bodega Bay, a region now known as the Fort Ross-Seaview AVA. Here, the interplay of warm sunshine, cool Pacific breezes, and sandstone soils yield the structure and complexity of the age-worthy wine that had captured their imagination. Today, under the direction of viticulturist, Greg Adams, and winemaker, Tanner Scheer, they farm five dramatic vineyards including Heaven & Earth, Zephyr Farms, Mohrhardt Ridge, Hagan, and The Estate.

TASTING NOTES:

"The 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon Mohrhardt Ridge Vineyard is a very pretty wine. Deep, layered, and distinctive. This is a very rare example of Cabernet on the true Sonoma Coast. There is plenty of flavor intensity packed into its mid-weight frame. Bright red/purplish fruit, rose petals, mint and blood orange linger on the vibrant, salivating finish." – Antonio Galloni, *Vinous*

DESCRIPTION:

The origin or meaning of the name “Enkidu” comes from one of the oldest stories ever recorded: The Epic of Gilgamesh. Written in Sumerian cuneiform nearly 4500 years ago, the story details the life of King Gilgamesh and his best friend Enkidu. As a winery, they take direction from the character of Enkidu, looking inward and adhering to beliefs that guide their everyday efforts. By working closely with growers, Enkidu requires the growers to take pride in the land and treat each vine with respect. All wines are handcrafted and produced with outstanding character and express the terroir from which the wine comes from.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2021 Enkidu Cabernet Sauvignon shows wonderful aromas of wild berries, and cocoa powder with hints of dried herbs and vanilla. The palate is full and very expressive delivering a mix of ripe currant and cherry flavors that are framed by fine tannins and a touch of spicy oak.
