Hendry Winery has a reputation for producing ultra-premium wines, particularly their Cabernet Sauvignon. They are known for their estate-grown wines, with a focus on showcasing the unique characteristics of their vineyard sites. The winery is family-owned and has been in operation for several decades. The winery was founded by George Hendry Sr. in 1939. Today the Hendry Ranch is composed of 203 acres situated in the low, rolling hills of Mt. Veeder. Of the 203 acres owned by the Hendry family 114 acres are planted for grapes.

“This deeply colored, extremely ripe, and concentrated wine from a cooler part of Napa Valley is powerful but smooth, a creamy texture carries blueberries, cocoa, and anise flavors wrapped in significant fine-grained tannins. TASTING NOTES:

Beautiful color; deep concentration, ruby to opaque. Rich and flavorful aromas of black cherry, and cassis with hints of dark fudge and vanilla. Full-bodied and quite dense on the palate. Concentrated with a beautiful structure. The wine has unending length and complexity all through the finish.
