TASTING NOTES:

Upfront aromas of ripe strawberries, potpourri, cedar, and wildflowers. Full-bodied with layers of dark fruits, sweet oak, and minerals. Wonderful mouthfeel, with a kiss of acid and sweet tannins on the backend.

### DESCRIPTION:

Amici Cellars is a family-owned winery set in the foothills of the Palisades, just outside Calistoga in Napa Valley. The winery is dedicated to producing true-to-varietals from exceptional vineyard sources. Leading the winemaking team is Tony Biagi and Matt Courtney. Together they bring decades of vineyard and grower relationships, that ensure the quality and consistency of Amici Cabernet Sauvignon.

### TASTING NOTES:

The 2021 Amici Napa Cabernet Sauvignon is a powerful, rich, and beautifully balanced wine. Dense aromas of dark cherry and plum are accented by hints of cocoa and creme de cassis. The full-bodied palate presents notes of ripe blackberry, dark chocolate, baking spices, and toasty oak. Silky tannins are laced throughout the long finish.

### DESCRIPTION:

Coup de Foudre in English translates to “lightning strikes” or when something unforgettable occurs that you want to capture forever. The meaning behind the Coup de Foudre label finds inspiration from when John Schwartz (owner) met his eventual wife in France. For the past 30 years, John and his wife have had the great fortune to work with wine, savor it, and witness its impact on consumers as they commemorate special times in their lives with wine, hence “Coupe de Foudre.”

### TASTING NOTES:

The 2021 Coup de Foudre Cabernet Sauvignon expresses intense aromatics of fresh dark berries with deep complex layers of melted cocoa and cassis. Full-bodied, yet well-balanced and elegant. The palate profile will bring you back to Bordeaux. Very limited, only 750 cases were produced.
