DESCRIPTION:

The creator and owner of this Cabernet Sauvignon is considered Napa 'Royal Pedigree.' Jeremy Nickel is the son of the great Gil Nickel who was the founder and owner of Far Niente and Nickel & Nickel wineries. Jeremy Nickel Cellars has collaborated with leading wine growers and well-known Napa Valley winemakers to develop his own personal touch on his wines. Today, all of Jeremy's wines express bold flavors, yet come across the palate with elegance and focus on ripe fruits.

TASTING NOTES:

This Napa Valley Cabernet expresses a bright purple-to-violet color. Very aromatic with layers of ripe black fruits, including black cherry, cassis, and crushed wild berries. Absolutely gorgeous on the palate, offering ripe blackberries, and spice with hints of mocha and toasted oak. Impressive, silky tannins support the bold fruit structure with a long-lasting finish.

DESCRIPTION:

The CRU Cabernet Sauvignon from Vineyard 29 is deeply rooted in the vineyards of St. Helena that surround their estate, with about 60% of the fruit coming from neighboring growers. Each year Vineyard 29 hand-selects the balance of the fruit from select vineyards throughout Napa Valley. A total of 14 different vineyards play a role in creating the CRU Cabernet Sauvignon.

The palate is full-flavored with plenty of grip and structure yet shows off purity and the elegance of Cabernet Sauvignon. This wine overdelivers and can be enjoyed now or will age another 7 years with proper cellaring.
