The 2018 Archimedes embodies an homage to the intellect and innovation of Archimedes of Syracuse, a legendary figure from ancient Greece. Crafted for discerning enthusiasts, Archimedes is a rare gem sourced from high-elevation vineyards in Alexander Valley. These vineyards benefit from extended sun exposure and moderated temperatures, ensuring a slow, steady ripening process that enhances flavor development.

TASTING NOTES:

“Opaque ruby-purple, the 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon Archimedes opens with wafts of menthol and rich cassis, with pure touches of pencil shavings, tobacco leaves, and exotic spices on the nose. The full-bodied palate is firm and grainy with bold, dark fruits and a mineral-laced finish.” – *Wine Advocate*

DESCRIPTION:

In January 2020, Florence & Daniel Cathiard, owners of Château Smith Haut Lafitte, ventured beyond France with Cathiard Vineyard. Situated along Napa Valley's Zinfandel Lane, the estate unfolds amid the serene beauty of the Mayacamas foothills. Spanning 250 acres, with 58 dedicated to vineyards, it harmonizes with nature, hosting diverse wildlife, including mountain lions. Vineyards ascend 1000 feet and are 14 blocks across St. Helena alluvial fan and Rutherford hillside slopes. The winery produces three red wines, all from estate fruit, organically farmed with low yields and minimal intervention. Focused on finesse, elegance, and drinkability, each bottle embodies its terroir.

TASTING NOTES:

"This inviting, chocolaty wine is super-soft in mouthfeel at first due to a full body and resolved tannins. But the tannins firm up on the finish to reveal a structure that can help it age well. Milk chocolate, blueberries, and mint bring a lot of flavor. Blended from 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, and 10% Malbec."

DESCRIPTION:

Three Furies Wines is the culmination of Martin Mackenzie's 25-year winemaking journey from New Zealand to Sonoma to Napa Valley. Founded in 2016 by Martin and his wife Shauna, each bottle reflects their pursuit of perfection and purity. From the famed Stonyridge Vineyard in New Zealand to Petroni Vineyards in Sonoma, Martin honed his craft before becoming head winemaker at Neal Family Vineyards in Napa Valley. Three Furies Wines offers a trio of exquisite Pinot Noirs—Constant Vengeance from Sta. Rita Hills, The Angry One from Santa Lucia Highlands, and The Jealous from Anderson Valley—each capturing the essence of its AVA.

TASTING NOTES:

Deep crimson-red with pure aromas of crushed pomegranate, raspberry, and ripe black cherries, accented by hints of sweet mint, sage, slate, and baguette crust. The palate exudes tension and power, supported by fine acidity and firm yet unobtrusive tannins. Ripe red fruits emerge, complemented by dense, ripe fruit tannins and earthy French oak complexity. The finish is fruit-forward with a subtle chalky tannin undertone.
