DESCRIPTION:

The sun-drenched 2015 vintage in Brunello di Montalcino shines through in this spellbinding Sangiovese. The vineyards of Poggio Landi are strewn over 74 hectares of varying terrains and altitudes, with the vines for this Riserva sitting as high as 400 meters. The cooler temperatures at this elevation helped to temper the summer's heat and the generous, plush fruit at the core of this stunning wine is balanced by fresh acidity and firm tannins.

The first whiff of vibrant cherries, crushed flowers, and sage is intoxicating. Ripe berry fruit floods the spectrum from currant and plum to Bing cherry and blackberry. Gentle, underlying hints of baking spice lend depth and complexity. This is what Sangiovese wants to be when it grows up—gorgeous, elegant, and sure to captivate.

DESCRIPTION:

World-class Cabernet Franc from Argentina? If you don't know, now you know! One of the top bottlings from Bodegas Aleanna, this revered and sought-after wine is a master class in terroir. The chalky soils of the Gualtallary vineyard are mirrored so clearly in the fine, chalky tannins of this exceptional offering. The high altitude (4800 ft above sea level) ensures that the grapes retain their natural acidity, even in a warm vintage such as 2017. 15 months in oak foudres rounds out the edges without compromising purity.

The nose: Fragrant, exotic spice box, from nutmeg to cumin and fennel seeds to wild mint. Floral notes of lavender and violet mingle with white pepper and sandalwood. Intense red fruit.

The palate: An almost citrusy, austere acidity and vibrant minerality frame layers of tart cherry, pomegranate syrup, and huckleberry. Medium to full body with gorgeous focus and tension. Bright and juicy with a mouthwatering finish.
