DESCRIPTION:

Dry Creek Winery farms 185 acres, and 100% of their vineyards are certified sustainable.

TASTING NOTES:

“At first swirl, notes of black currant, blackberry, and cranberry come forward, followed by deeper aromatics of clove and orange zest. Additional airing reveals nuances of cardamom and mocha. On the palate, elegant flavors of boysenberry and plum mingle with complex notes of cinnamon, toasty cedar, and bay leaf. The refined tannins are well-integrated, providing a rich and luxurious mouthfeel with a long, lingering finish.”

DESCRIPTION:

Coup de Foudre in English translates to “lightning strikes” or when something unforgettable occurs that you want to capture forever. The meaning behind the Coup de Foudre label finds inspiration from when John Schwartz (owner) met his eventual wife in France. For the past 30 years, John and his wife have had the great fortune to work with wine, savor it, and witness its impact on consumers as they commemorate special times in their lives with wine, hence Coupe de Foudre.

TASTING NOTES:

Les Bouquinistes, a Napa Valley field blend, is one of the most intriguing wines within the Coup de Foudre family of wines. Dark, youthful color, almost opaque. The nose offers ripe crushed berry notes with hints of tart pomegranate and sweet floral spice. The palate is full of energy, showcasing layers of red and black fruit flavors with the right amount of tannins and acidity. This is a gorgeous wine.

DESCRIPTION:

Ontañón is the name of the mountain valley where for many generations the Pérez-Cuevas family has owned land. The family's identity is rooted in this sub-region of Rioja Oriental, which is located near their hometown of Quel. Bodega Ontañón is a multi-generational family-owned winery. Raquel, Rubén, and María Pérez Cuevas are the fifth generation of the Pérez Cuevas family to carry on the tradition of grape growing in the southern part of Rioja.

TASTING NOTES:

Beautiful and bright layers of ruby are displayed in the glass with aromas of red cherry. This wine offers a rich blend of spices, minerality, and bright fruit while finely laced with hints of vanilla, cacao, and toasted oak. It is elegant, complex, and a perfect balance of terroir – from where it originated. It is to be enjoyed at the moment as well as for decades to come.

"The 2021 Chardonnay Mon Trajet Bentrock Vineyard is so promising. Soft, delicate contours frame a core of orchard fruit, white flowers, mint, and white pepper. Bentrock Chardonnays are typically a bit more nervy than this, but I must say I find plenty to like in this decidedly caressing style."

Their shared passion for great wine brought them to wild, windy, and remote northern Santa Barbara County where they spent the next several years seeking out extraordinary, cool-climate vineyards and dedicating themselves to careful, patient, minimalist winemaking.

TASTING NOTES:

“From a great terroir on the western side of the Sta. Rita Hills, the 2021 Pinot Noir Radian Vineyard has a semi-opaque ruby hue as well as a terrific nose of mulled black cherries, scorched earth, toasted spice, and savory herbs. With tons of salty, mineral nuances on the palate, it is medium to full-bodied, and has perfectly integrated acidity, ripe tannins, and outstanding length. It’s one of my favorites in the lineup from Dragonette in 2021. It will have 15+ years of overall longevity.” —Jeb Dunnuck
