In 2001, two generations of the Cobb family came together to explore a shared passion for Pinot Noir. David and Diane were pioneers of the far Sonoma Coast when they planted Coastlands Vineyard with their son Ross in 1989. The convergence of Ross's winemaking talents and his parents' development of Coastlands Vineyard led to the creation of Cobb Wines.

TASTING NOTES:

"Medium ruby, the 2019 Pinot Noir Wendling Vineyard offers pure cranberry, red cherry, pomegranate, and rhubarb fruit, with accents of forest floor, conifer and Angostura bitters. The medium-bodied palate is powerful and spicy, with loads of silty tannins, a deep core of spicy fruit and a very long, nuanced finish."

DESCRIPTION:

The entire Girardin family are renowned winemakers, including Jacques' father Jean, and his well-known brother, Vincent. Jacques has been producing wine from his own Domaine since 1978. Located in Santenay, the 17-hectare Domaine Jacques Girardin produces a range of red and white wines, featuring 1er Cru sites in Santenay, Savigny-lès-Beaune, and Chassagne-Montrachet, as well as an exceptional old vine Bourgogne Pinot Noir.

TASTING NOTES:

A classic Savigny-Lès-Beaune with the sour-cherry aroma, rather sleek body, and lively acidity that you expect from this appellation. Healthy tannins that are moderately dry. Good length, the refreshing finish is both slightly sappy and mineral.

DESCRIPTION:

Pascal Clément was born in the village of Savigny-lès-Beaune to a family of grape growers, where his father founded the Maison in 1950. After 20+ years as a grower and winemaker in his home region, including his time at legendary Domaine Coche-Dury in Meursault, in 2012 he launched his own négociant project. Pascal works with fifteen farmers and vineyard owners across the Côte de Nuits, and personally selects and tends to the vineyard plots that he chooses to work with.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2019 Pascal Clément Savigny-lès-Beaune Les Serpentières Ier Cru offers a deep cherry/crimson color with bright garnet highlights. Classic Burgundy aromatics, showcasing blackcurrants and crushed berries with a note of spice and wildflowers. The palate offers an upfront and full, rich texture and is quite round. The tannins are discreet and allow the power of this wine to shine.

Michael’s current passion has turned to Cabernet Sauvignon. Michael’s inspiration for Cabernet Sauvignon goes back to the early 1980s when he first arrived in Napa Valley. The Trujillo Cabernet Sauvignon is the realization of Michael’s history, knowledge, and experience, bringing his vineyard passion together with more than 34 years of winemaking proficiency.

TASTING NOTES:

“The 2019 Trujillo Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is provocative with its rich deep color, enticing with bountiful dark fruit expressions, lavish with its copious well-rounded tannins, and gravitating with complexity and balanced structure. The aromas give way to rousing black cherry, black currant, and dark cocoa. On the palate, the wine seamlessly transpires with elegance and complexity giving way to a rich, velvety, and lengthy finish.”

2021 Domaine Bouard-Bonnefoy Saint Aubin 1er Cru Les Charmois

DESCRIPTION:

Domaine Bouard-Bonnefoy sets the standard for naturally made, profoundly flavorful white Burgundy. This winemaking family represents a Burgundy that many have thought to be long gone, but the Bouard-Bonnefoy family embodies the sort of artisanal spirit to which many wine enthusiasts and collectors have always been drawn to. The Bouard-Bonnefoy family farms sustainably, avoiding pesticides and herbicides, and uses indigenous yeasts for fermentation. As in most of Burgundy, the harvest at Bouard-Bonnefoy is always by hand.

TASTING NOTES:

The Le Charmois vineyard site is essentially a continuation of Chassagne's top premier cru vineyards, climbing up the valley (and within a stone's throw of Montrachet). With a little more altitude, the winds are a bit cooler, so 'Charmois' is a reliable source of a vibrant and tantalizing white Burgundy. Bright aromas of green apple, and white peach with hints of fresh minerals. The palate is full of energy and refreshing, crisp core fruits with a long and well-structured finish.
