The hallmark of Arkenstone wines is first and foremost, well-crafted, quality, with vintage-to-vintage consistency throughout their entire portfolio of wines. Their flagship wines are from their estate which reflects the uniqueness of its terroir. The NVD wines are all sourced from locations that allow Arkenstone to expand their portfolio into other vineyards situated in the higher elevations of the Eastern Napa Mountains.

TASTING NOTES:

"The 2018 NVD Cabernet Sauvignon is made from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon and was aged for 22 months in French oak barrels, 80% new. Deep garnet-purple in color, the nose reveals notes of warm plums, baked black currants, and black cherries with suggestions of clove oil, black tea, Chinese five spice, and cedar. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is packed with firm, crunchy blackberry flavors with bags of freshness and plush tannins, finishing with compelling energy." — Wine Advocate

SIXTO is owned and operated by Charles Smith. Charles is a highly acclaimed and influential winemaker in Washington State. He is known for his distinctive personality and unconventional approach to winemaking. To say that Charles has made an impact on the wine industry is truly an understatement.

Today, Charles owns 6 different wineries in Washington State. One of the brands is SIXTO. Inspired by the story of Musician, Sixto Rodriguez, and the acclaimed documentary, Searching for Sugar Man, Charles similarly wanted to resurrect something that was abandoned but wanting to be rediscovered. The Chardonnay's from SIXTO, are known for their richness, complexity, and balance.

TASTING NOTES:

"Lots of white peaches and cooked apples with honey and lilac undertones. It's full-bodied yet remains so lively and layered with some notes of cookie and apple skin at the end. Some notes of licorice and aniseed here, too." — James Suckling

DESCRIPTION:

Waypoint is the vision of Alejandro Bulgheroni, an Argentinian-Italian businessman, farmer, and vintner. When Waypoint was created it was a wonderful opportunity to begin sourcing fruit from famous plots. Waypoint enabled the winemaking team to dig into its Rolodex files and find the best fruit from unique places that deserve a little more attention. It all starts with fantastic vineyards and folks who farm them sustainably. There are plenty of important decisions that follow, but ultimately, it's about letting the wines speak for themselves and listening to the historic terroir express itself. Single-vineyard wines need to stand on their own merit. Waypoint harnesses that belief and lets the vineyard and corresponding wine do all the talking.

TASTING NOTES:

"The 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon Lowrey Vineyard Homestead comes from the New Frontier umbrella (owned by Alejandro Bulgheroni) and is a 100% Cabernet Sauvignon that saw 20 months in 78% new French oak. This rich, satisfying Cabernet reveals a dense purple color, impressive blackcurrant, and cassis fruits, notes of chocolate, tobacco, and earth, medium to full-bodied richness, and a great sense of minerality on the finish. Enjoy bottles over the coming 10-15 years." — Jeb Dunnuck

TASTING NOTES:

Youthful ruby color with a hint of purple (violet) around the rim. The aromatics jump from the glass featuring ripe cherry and cranberry aromas with a hint of bacon fat. Medium-bodied on the palate offering classic coastal red fruit flavors with sweet ripe tannins.

DESCRIPTION:

Pine Ridge Winery is one of the hidden gems of the Napa Valley. They produce some of the finest Cabernet Napa has to offer. Year in and year out, this winery receives some of the highest scores from wine critics around the nation. Founded in 1978 by Gary Andrus, Pine Ridge sits in the heart of the Stags Leap District. Today, the winery owns estate vineyards in five premier Napa Valley appellations, including Howell Mountain, and Rutherford. At Pine Ridge Vineyards, they are committed to sustainable farming practices and take every step to preserve the ecosystem. They are also "Napa Green" certified.

TASTING NOTES:

Beautiful cranberry red color. Forward fruit aromatics of black cherry and cassis begin to make your mouth water before the first sip! On the palate, juicy notes of blueberry compote and cherry cordial meld seamlessly with hints of cinnamon and cream soda. The wine methodically transitions from the bright, round entry through the viscous midpalate and onto a broad-shouldered finish.
