Priest Ranch believes that all wines must stem from the land itself. Director of Winemaking and Viticulture Craig Becker and Winemaker Cody Hurd draw on their rich, diverse estate vineyard to bring the Priest Ranch wines to life. Featuring a variety of elevations, exposures, soils, and microclimates, their estate provides fruit with uncommon quality and character for all of the Priest Ranch wines.

TASTING NOTES:

“The 2018 Snake Oil has a beautiful deep and rich ruby color. On the nose, there are pleasant complex aromas of earth and spice with notes of warm chocolate mocha. Hints of blueberry, black cherries, and berry cobbler immediately scream from the glass. This wine has muscular tannins that grip at the beginning and linger to a beautiful silky-long finish.” – *Cody Hurd, winemaker*

DESCRIPTION:

Larkmead Vineyards is one of the oldest family-owned establishments in Napa Valley. Originally founded in 1895, the Larkmead Estate is now under the stewardship of the Solari-Baker family. Kate and Cam Baker have been the dynamic force behind Larkmead's transformation from a historic vineyard into a world-renowned wine estate. In 2005 they built the first phase of a state-of-the-art winery on the property. This project allowed each vineyard block to have its own dedicated vinification tank. To say the least, they were way ahead of their time.

TASTING NOTES:

“Deep garnet-purple colored, it leaps from the glass with redcurrant jelly, blackberry preserves, and fresh blackcurrant scents, plus hints of sautéed herbs, damp soil, tapenade, and truffles. The medium to full-bodied palate is finely textured with lovely freshness to lift the generous fruit, delivering a savory finish.” – *Wine Advocate*

DESCRIPTION:

Bel Colle Winery was formed by three brothers in 1977. It is located on the northwest edge of the Barolo DOCG. The winery was purchased by Luca Bosio in 2015. Luca is one of the most innovative young winemakers in the Piedmont region. Luca seized the opportunity to work with such a prestigious property, which is known for producing single-vineyard Barolo and Barbaresco.

TASTING NOTES:

Pure elegance in a glass, the 2017 Bel Colle Barbaresco DOCG offers up a beautiful ruby red color with slight orange hues. This Nebbiolo exhibits violets and a hint of spice aromas that support a velvety finish.

DESCRIPTION:

Les Granières de La Nerthe captures the spirit of Châteauneuf-du-Pape with its mosaic of soils and grape varieties. It illustrates the elegance of finesse of the wines from Château La Nerthe, the famed property owned by the Richard Family. The name originates from the granary, or attic space where the château stored grains at the time when local agriculture included food production.

TASTING NOTES:

“Juicy and direct, with tasty raspberry and blackberry coulis notes backed by anise and apple wood accents. Shows sweet spice and fruitcake notes that chime through the toasty finish, while the fruit keeps pace.” – *Wine Spectator*

DESCRIPTION:

This Premier Cru comes from a small plot within the larger 'Morgeot' appellation in Chassagne-Montrachet, situated on lower slopes rich in slate, limestone, and clay. Great wines are also produced on the relatively lower slopes, with not too much sun during the day and a struggle through the sticks to get as deep as possible to get enough water. The boulder soil in the Abbaye provides a beautiful minerality within a rich style of wine. Jean Fery strongly believes in organic viticulture with great respect for nature.

TASTING NOTES:

Beautiful and elegant! The 2020 Domaine Jean Fery exhibits floral aromas with a hint of flint indicative of the high limestone levels in the soils from which it is grown. The palate has an amazing structure, showcasing notes of bold citrus fruit and green apple with rounded edges that subside into a focused, lingering finish.

Beguiling aromas of blackberry cobbler, raspberry, and cherry pipe tobacco anticipate hints of toasty oak, black licorice, and pencil shaving. Lush and full-bodied, this wine bestows rich flavors of cherry, black plum, dark chocolate, and blueberry compote with lovely accents of Zante currant, graphite, and cinnamon.”
