Originally from Southern Italy, now in California, the Bruno Family presents wines from the fruit of some of the most sought-after vineyards in Napa and Sonoma. With three generations in agriculture, the Brunos are proud stewards of the land and active community members. Their wines are a salute to the importance of bringing family together through the appreciation and enjoyment of good food and wine.

TASTING NOTES:

“The 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Beckstoffer Georges III Vineyard that was brought up in a mix of new French and American oak. Its deep purple color is followed by a gorgeous wine that’s a spitting image of class and finesse. Currants, high-class oak, hints of crème de cassis, and crushed flowers all flow to a layered, full-bodied, multi-dimensional beauty that does everything right. With fine tannin, beautiful purity of fruit, and a great finish.” – *Jeb Dunnuck*

**DESCRIPTION:**

Farella is a family-owned vineyard and winery based out of the Coombsville appellation in Napa Valley. Founded in 1977, the first wines were produced in 1985. Frank Farella was the first to plant Cabernet Sauvignon vines in the Coombsville AVA, it is also the home of the first Cabernet wine produced in the AVA. Today the winery and the estate are being looked after by Frank's son Tom Farella. Tom strives to create age-worthy wines that reflect the nuance and character of the Coombsville AVA.

**TASTING NOTES:**

Wonderfully deep and concentrated color. The aromas show off dark fruits and warm spices, with a touch of cherry and blackberry jam. The palate offers a beautiful structure, full-bodied yet still elegant. Ripe blue and black fruits with well-defined tannins that linger for quite some time. Very limited and rare, less than 100 cases were produced.

**DESCRIPTION:**

Tapiz Winery is located in Mendoza's Uco Valley and has one of the highest vineyards in Mendoza at 4,600 feet. Tapiz is owned by the Ortiz family. Under the ownership of Patricia Ortiz, Tapiz has become a pioneer in the region and helped develop San Pablo into one of Argentina's most renowned IGs. The highly rated wines of Tapiz are made by the celebrated winemaking team of Fabián Valenzuela and famed Bordeaux winemaker Jean-Claude Berrouet (winemaker of Château Pétrus for 44 vintages). Take note, this is a winery to follow.

**TASTING NOTES:**

"Delivers aromas of petrichor and dried violet that make for an alluring entry, while the palate offers nice vibrancy to well-defined plum and red currant flavors. Offers nuances of mineral and olive that fold in around fine tannins and a lingering note of dark chocolate." – *Wine Spectator*

**DESCRIPTION:**

In 2000, Douglas and Ana Lucia Stewart bought this 203-acre farm in the heart of Anderson Valley. It had been a sheep ranch for 150 years. Oaks, bays, and madrones lined the four creeks and dotted the rolling hills of the watershed. Every winter the oaks lost their leaves but the green ghostly garb of lichen remained. Lichen is everywhere there, from the Yorkville Highlands to the Mendocino Coast. Doug and Ana Lucia named our farm “Lichen Estate” in honor of its beauty and grace.

**TASTING NOTES:**

For this wine, Doug selects his 5 finest barrels to make sure that this Estate wine is of the highest quality. The wine offers expressive aromas of bright plums, black cherry, and toasty oak. The palate is rich, and well-textured, offering bright cranberry, and red fruit flavors, with youthful, and very ripe tannins.

DESCRIPTION:

The team at Remoissenet wears two hats: one, as a high-quality, small-batch negotiant, cultivating close relationships with wine growers up and down the Côte. The second hat is a winegrowing estate with select vineyards. The majority of the vines are located in Beaune and Gevrey-Chambertin. All the vines are being cared for according to biodynamic principles. In 2005, Remoissenet started the next chapter in its generations-long history. With new owners and renewed leadership under Pierre-Antoine Rovani and Bernard Repolt, the estate is bringing on more vineyards to ensure the highest quality of each wine produced.

TASTING NOTES:

Beautiful youthful color, ripe aromas of red cherries, wildflowers with a note of cassis and vanilla. The palate shows medium-weight, with wonderful flavors of plums and spice. Well balanced with really good length all through the finish.

**DESCRIPTION:**

Hourglass boutique winery is located in the heart of Napa Valley. The winery was established in the early 90s by Jeff Smith and his wife Carolyn, with the goal of producing high-quality, limited-production wines. The winery takes its name from its unique vineyard site, which is shaped like an hourglass due to the narrowing of the valley floor. The winemaking philosophy at Hourglass emphasizes precision and attention to detail. All the grapes are hand-harvested and hand-sorted to ensure only the highest-quality fruit is used. Hourglass wines have gained critical acclaim and are highly sought after by wine enthusiasts and collectors.

**TASTING NOTES:**

Rich, and concentrated color. Bold, with upfront cassis, blackberry, and dried herb aromas. The palate is full-bodied with layers of crushed blueberry, wild cherry with ripe tannins. A beautiful wine that has great texture and structure throughout the finish.
