DESCRIPTION:

Knights Bridge Winery is a boutique winery located in the Knights Valley AVA in Sonoma County. The winery was founded in 2006 by Dr. Jim Bailey, a retired cardiac surgeon and wine enthusiast, with the goal of producing world-class Chardonnay as well as other Bordeaux Varietals. Knights Bridge Winery is known for its limited-production, estate-grown wines, which are crafted by winemaker Douglas Danielak using traditional techniques and minimal intervention.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2019 vintage delivers a refined expression of Chardonnay sourced from multiple parcels on the Knights Bridge Estate Vineyard. The wine showcases bright and refreshing aromas of Meyer Lemon and sweet brioche. The middle palate has ample energy with vibrant citrus fruits and fine pastry crust flavors complemented by a thread of minerality that runs through the finish. This is a Chardonnay that will age gracefully and is cellared correctly.

DESCRIPTION:

Beringer Vineyards is a historic winery located in St. Helena, California, USA. It was founded in 1876 by two brothers, Jacob and Frederick Beringer, who immigrated to the United States from Germany. Beringer is one of the oldest continuously operating wineries in Napa Valley and is known for producing premium wines. Beringer produces a wide range of wines including their highly acclaimed Beringer's Private Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon and Knights Valley Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, both wines are well-known and have received numerous accolades. Beringer has been owned by several different companies over the years, including Nestlé and Treasury Wine Estates, and remains a prominent and respected winery in Napa Valley.

TASTING NOTES:

Dark violet with shimmering garnet tones. The aromas are very inviting with layers of ripe black cherry, boysenberry, and hints of tea leaf and wildflowers. The palate is rich and very complex with ripe black fruits, and crème de cassis. Velvety smooth and concentrated finish, along with a great texture and balance.

DESCRIPTION:

Adobe Road is a small boutique winery with unique ties to the world of automobiles and motorsports. Championship race car driver Kevin Buckler established Adobe Road Winery in 2002 with a commitment to creating the very best small-lot wines by sourcing premier fruit from some of the finest family-owned vineyards in Sonoma County and Napa Valley. All wines are hand-crafted to perfection. Their wines are expressive of the individual vineyard and appellation. Adobe Road wines have garnered over seventy 90+ scores from the Wine Spectator, and Robert Parker from the Wine Advocate.

TASTING NOTES:

This 2021 'Bavarian Lion' Cabernet Sauvignon is deeply colored with some violet highlights. Complexed and well-layered aromas of blackberries, and cassis with notes of freshly crushed fruits. The palate is full and very expressive, offering dark berry flavors with a wonderful texture. The finish is firm, with ripe tannins, yet still sleek and elegant.
