**DESCRIPTION:**

Guy Amiot is a prominent winemaker from the Burgundy region of France. His family has been making wine in the region for more than a century, and he continues to uphold their tradition of producing high-quality wines. Domaine Guy Amiot is one of very few Domaines that are 100% Estate. Being 100% Estate means that they do not purchase fruit from other growers within the Burgundy region.

Guy and his wife, Marie-Josophe, own and operate Domaine Guy Amiot et Fils, which is located in the village of Chassagne-Montrachet in Burgundy. The domain is known for its exceptional white and red wines, particularly its Chassagne-Montrachet Premier Cru as well as the value-driven appellation wines. The vineyards are meticulously tended, with a focus on sustainable and organic farming practices. Overall, Guy Amiot is a highly regarded winemaker whose wines are widely sought after by enthusiasts and collectors around the world.

**TASTING NOTES:**

This is a beautiful Burgundy that is sure to delight all palates. Bright and youthful ruby color. The aromatics start with spice and red fruits with notes of truffle. The palate is fruity and crisp, followed by a luscious density of red berries and spice. Firm tannins and complexity all come together in the finish.

**DESCRIPTION:**

Owner-Winemaker Chris Dearden found his first introduction to wine with family around their dinner table. Chris was raised in California's Central Valley, where he developed a passion for agriculture. Over the years Chris has worn many hats, including winemaker, general manager, and consulting winemaker for many small wineries throughout Napa Valley. In 2010 Chris achieved his lifelong dream – to establish Dearden Wine Portfolio. These wines include his flagship wines, 'Sleeping Giant' Cabernet Sauvignon, 'Little Giant' Cabernet Sauvignon, as well as his only Pinot Noir named 'Argus.'

**TASTING NOTES:**

Showing the classic Burgundy ruby color, the wine jumps from the glass, offering rich, red plum, and strawberries with an accent of citrus and tea. The palate is full-bodied, yet still elegant and pure. Silky smooth flavors of cranberry, and black cherry with a touch of vanilla on the backend. The finish is very well-focused and nicely textured.

Simple sustainable farming, hands-off winemaking, and a passion for Pinot Noir dictate the mission of Averaen Wines. The first vintage of Averaen Wines was in 2016. They sourced their fruit from well-known and premium vineyards throughout the Willamette Valley. The wine was an instant success nationally and received a 91-point score from Vinous. Today, Averaen continues to source outstanding grapes from well-established vineyards and top-notch growers.

**TASTING NOTES:**

Showcasing beautiful red-ruby color. The aromas offer bright cherry notes with classical hints of wildflowers and spice accents. The palate displays ripe flavors of sweet raspberry, and dark cherry with a wonderful savory note towards the backend. A very long finish and well-structured wine.
