DESCRIPTION:

To create the 'Terroir Series' Pinot Noir, individual barrels are selected by the winemaker from Alexana's single vineyard program. This will bring together four distinct 'Terroirs' to create a unique bottle of Pinot Noir from the Willamette Valley. Each vineyard block is fermented separately in small batches with native yeasts before resting in French Oak for 10 months.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2021 Alexana Terroir Series Pinot Noir is a real charmer. Revealing a beautiful red-ruby color with youthful highlights. Bright aromas of tart red currants, and cranberry with a savory spice. The palate is full and quite ripe, well balanced with red plum, and cherry with a touch of citrus on the finish.

DESCRIPTION:

The name Martin Ray resonates deeply in the history of California Winemaking. Martin Ray was a pioneer in the wine industry, dedicated to producing single varietals and region-specific wine. Ray was active from 1943 to 1972 in Saratoga, the heart of Santa Cruz Mountains. He took a decidedly Burgundian style to his winemaking and developed what is now one of the most historical properties in California, known as Mount Eden.

Nearly twenty years after Martin Ray's passing, Courtney Benham stumbled upon 1,500 cases of Martin Ray wine in a San Jose warehouse. Recognizing his good fortune, and his intent and drive to produce terroir-driven wines, Ray's historical significance and philosophy resonated with him. Courtney purchased the brand, and since 1990 has been committed to the production of artisanal wines worthy of the Martin Ray name.
