Clos de Napa is produced by Trevor Sheenan, owner of Precision Wine Company. As the name suggests, Trevor makes sure that 'Precision' with each wine is achieved with meticulous attention to detail and commitment to quality. Trevor started his journey to create a top wine collection when he became a winemaker 10 years ago. He carefully defined his own wine-making style over the years drawing inspiration from fellow winemakers and mentors, Nils Venge and Henri Mayer.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2019 Clos de Napa 'Reserve' Pinot Noir is highly aromatic and very expressive. Truly a classic Pinot Noir, offering bright bing cherry, violets, and savory spice. The palate is elegant and well-balanced between the crisp acidity and sweet tannins. The finish is well-focused and polished. A wonderful wine to enjoy now.

DESCRIPTION:

Pascal Clément was born in the village of Savigny-lès-Beaune to a family of grape growers, where his father founded the Maison in 1950. After 20+ years as a grower and winemaker in his home region, including his time at legendary Domaine Coche-Dury in Meursault, in 2012 he launched his own négociant project. Pascal works with fifteen farmers and vineyard owners across the Côte de Nuits, and personally selects and tends to the vineyard plots that he chooses to work with.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2021 Pascal Clément Aloxe-Corton offers a beautiful, bright ruby-to-garnet color. The aromas are upfront and ripe, showcasing dark berries, black cherry, and plum notes. On the palate, the wine is full and very rich, yet still elegant and well. It is truly a beautiful wine that all will enjoy.

DESCRIPTION:

When Walt and Joan Flowers saw a newspaper ad for 321 acres of land on the Sonoma Coast, just 2 miles from the Pacific Ocean, they were immediately intrigued but took pause. Only a few families – the Hirsches and the Bohans – were successfully growing grapes in such a cool part of California. Thankfully the Flowers ignored the ‘experts’ and planted Camp Meeting Ridge in 1991, named for its history as an Indian encampment and later, a site for religious retreats. Today Flowers is known for making some of the finest Chardonnay and Pinot Noir in America.

TASTING NOTES:

A beautiful mix of red and blue fruit on the nose unfolds with distinctive layers of violets, spice notes, and the fresh, haunting quality of an evergreen forest. Hints of blueberries join a burst of cherry on the palate, grounded and brightened in equal measure by fine-grained tannins and deliciously juicy acidity.
