TASTING NOTES:

Here is a WOW Pinot Noir! Offering an onslaught of red berry fruits with a solid core of sweet tobacco leaf and hints of dried potpourri. The palate is quite rich and expressive with layers of dark cherry and savory spice. Long and complex finish.

DESCRIPTION:

Frédéric Magnien is a fifth-generation winemaker from Mo-rey-Saint-Denis, and Burgundy is the family lifeblood. He learned the craft from his father Michel Magnien. He then traveled to Australia and California to hone his winemaking skills before returning home to Burgundy. There is no doubt that Frédéric knows all the ins and outs of Burgundy. As a young boy he used to ride his bike through all the premier cru and grand cru vineyards, and as the winemaker of Magnien, he still rides his bike through the vineyards to keep that home-grown feeling.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2021 Magnien Gevery-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes offers wonderful aromas of red cherry and herbal teas. The palate showcases medium weight with very good energy and bright minerals with flavors bursting of black cherries. The finish is long and well-balanced with ripe tannins and the right amount of acidity.

DESCRIPTION:

Waypoint was born out of the idea to spotlight single vineyard properties throughout California and to highlight the unique terroir and characteristics of each of these singular plots of soil. Between Pinot Noir, Cabernet, Merlot, and Petit Verdot, Waypoint was one of the first brands in California to emphasize sourcing fruit from one specific locale and giving it the credit it was due.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2021 Waypoint Pinot Noir shows bright red cherry notes with a slight hint of clove-like spice and refreshing minerals. The palate leads in with brisk red fruits, black raspberry, and sweet plum flavors. The finish is ripe with a wonderful structure and length.
