DESCRIPTION:

Three Furies Wines is a manifestation of Winemaker Martin Mackenzie's insatiable curiosity and a quest for truth, power, and beauty in wine. Martin, a New Zealand native, crafted wines for world-renowned Stonyridge Vineyard on remote Waiheke Island, New Zealand for ten years before moving to California wine country. He has been in California since 2009 working as a consultant and head winemaker. Martin has produced wines with top scores and earned high critical praise for his craft. Three Furies Wines are Martin's expression of respect for the power of nature.

TASTING NOTES:

Very expressive Burgundian garnet color, bright and youthful. The aromas are complex with layers of dark cherry, and wild berries with notes of sweet earth and savory spice. The palate is quite intense and well-textured. Full-bodied and powerful, yet still comes across as elegant and well-balanced. The finish is ripe with polished tannins and very long.

DESCRIPTION:

Marsannay is the northernmost wine-growing region in the Côte de Nuit. The appellation of Marsannay is unique in Burgundy for having AOC status for its red, white, and rose wines. Domaine Jean Fournier dates back to the reign of Louis 13th in the early 17th century, making it one of the oldest properties in Marsannay. Today the Domain's 16 hectares (39 acres) are managed by Laurent Fournier who also creates the wines. He has converted the vineyards to organic agriculture and has been Ecocert certified since 2008. Old vines can be found throughout his vineyards, contributing to the immense purity and finesse Fournier's wines are known for.

TASTING NOTES:

Offering a bright and youthful color, garnet to cherry red. This wine showcases wonderful floral and red fruit aromatics with a note of earth and sweet oak. The palate is medium-bodied, and well-balanced between the bright fruit flavors and crisp acidity. The finish will have your palate asking for more, as it develops nicely with every sip.

DESCRIPTION:

Darling Winery is a small family-owned winery that produces less than 1,500 cases annually. All wines from Darling are produced using native yeasts and neutral oak. To make the cleanest wines possible, these wines are typically unfiltered and unfined. Darling Wines focus is on producing wines with a lighter touch, yet they are still elegant and energetic. Many of Tom's wines have been featured at (5) three-star Michelin Star restaurants in California.

TASTING NOTES:

Beautiful, bright garnet color with wonderful rose highlights along the rim. Aromas of bright red cherries, and sweet earth with dried flowers on the backend. Medium-bodied, with a very silky texture. Ripe red fruit flavors with a noticeable amount of spice. This is one of California's hidden gems.
