**DESCRIPTION:**

This is the second release of Vincent Christopher; a singular Pinot Noir bottling, expressing the extreme viticulture of one the West Sonoma Coast's most exciting and exclusive sites. A passion project, named for their two sons, this is also the realization of a long-held desire by vintners Stanley and Helen Cheng to craft a California Pinot Noir with the depth, balance, and grace to rival their favorite Burgundy grand crus.

This wine shows lovely complexity with black cherry, cinnamon, orange rind and vanilla. The palate has a generous amount of cranberry, raspberry and hibiscus to it, tight tannins, a wave of fresh acidity, and a fruit-forward, tangy finish. Truly a great expression of Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir.

DESCRIPTION:

This wine is born from the best grape selection of our farm 22 Block I with special characteristics that distinguish this terroir with its herbal and spicy floral notes, and its red fruit typical of Pinot Noir of cold zone. Harvested in March fermented in concrete vessels using the whole cluster technique by 50%. Once malolactic fermentation finished it was aged in untoasted French oak foudres for 18-20 months.

Delicate ruby red with purple reflections. Great Pinot Noir character with notes of raspberries and cherries combined with herbal hints such as oregano thyme, truffle and flowers. Great complexity and finesse are found in this splendid Patagonia wine. Delicate and persistent structure. Silky tannins combined with firm natural acidity give it a unique vibrancy and depth. Of medium intensity, its great characteristic is the finesse and complexity of this Pinot Noir.

**DESCRIPTION:**

The clones planted in this vineyard block grow in a high mineral content soil. The site is refreshed by oceanic breezes which allow the fruit to fully develop and give a distinct character to the wine

Carmine red in colour, this Pinot Noir is bright, elegant and expressive with aromas reminiscent of cherries and roses. Flavors of intense red fruits subtly unfold in the palate. The right tannin presence makes it an excellent wine in its complexity.
