DESCRIPTION:

Jean-Baptiste Bouzereau took the winemaking reins from his father, Michel, back in 1999. An impressive figure to follow, Michel Bouzereau is a man of great sway in Burgundy. He was at one time the President of the prestigious Burgundy Growers' Union. His son, Jean-Baptiste, is now responsible for making some of the most enjoyable wines grown within the Côte d'Or and all through the Côte de Beaune. Jean-Baptiste has forged his own impressive style and although not certified, he tends to his vines organically.

TASTING NOTES:

This wine opens up with classic Burgundy terroir aromas of ripe red cherry fruits with a wave of wildflowers and spice. Medium-bodied on the palate, displaying ripe notes of Rainier cherry, and wild strawberry with just a kiss of acidity on the end. Long, well-balanced finish.

**TASTING NOTES:**

“The 2021 Reserve Pinot Noir is a perfect representation of the powerful structure of Eola-Amity Hills and the balanced delicacy of Dundee Hills fruit. Influenced by the terroir of these AVAs, this Pinot Noir fluidly transitions between ripe black cherry to blackberry and cardamon to nutmeg. Plushy, integrated tannins supported by fresh acidity are achieved by fermenting in small vessels and gentle aging.” — *Nate Klostermann, Winemaker*

**TASTING NOTES:**

The 2021 Dearden 'Sleeping Giant' Pinot Noir is absolutely gorgeous. It showcases aromas of pure red fruits, raspberry, and sweet botanical earth. The palate is medium-bodied with a sleek and smooth texture. Very concentrated berry fruits with a wave of spice and minerals across the long finish.
