**DESCRIPTION:**

Located in the region of Gevrey-Chambertain is Domaine Livera. The Estate has been run by the Livera family for several generations and is renowned for its commitment to sustainable and environmentally friendly winemaking practices. The estate offers a range of wines from the Côte de Nuits, ranging from AOC (Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée), Premier Cru, and Grand Cru. Domaine Philippe Livera wines have often been described by critics around the world as “elegant, complexed with a wonderful expression of the terroir from which the wine is grown.”

**TASTING NOTES:**

A beautiful, youthful ruby/maroon color. Expressing wonderful black and red summer berries, and licorice, with savory baking spiced notes. On the palate, this wine is straightforward and round, with complex dark fruit flavors with velvety, smooth tannins. The finish is very long, with notes of sweet oak and spice.

**DESCRIPTION:**

Ben Herod, formerly of Oro En Paz has started a new project called Nue Wilde Wines. Ben is very passionate about working with independent vineyards across California and producing single-vineyard expressions from old vines. Ben's winemaking journey began in 2004, producing a single barrel of wine in his San Francisco garage. Over the next five years, his production grew, which allowed him to create the Nue Wilde brand.

**TASTING NOTES:**

The 2021 'Eden Rift' Pinot Noir goes through 75% whole cluster fermentation. This gentle winemaking technique helps bring out the lighter and fruitier side of this Pinot. Showcasing beautiful aromas of wildflowers, red berries, and plum notes. The palate is round with a wonderful texture, layers of ripe (red) plum, and Rainier cherries with touches of savory spice.

**DESCRIPTION:**

Richard (Dick) Peterson is well-known in the California wine industry as an innovator, winemaker, educator, and wine judge. The Richard G. Peterson Wines are one of the most unique projects in Napa Valley, accompanied by a fascinating story. For many years, Dick Peterson has been a Napa Valley icon. Dick became the wine master at Beaulieu Vineyards following the famed André Tchelistcheff and then moved on to Monterey Vineyards, and then off to Atlas Peak and many other high-profile brands. Among Dick's achievements is the cultivation of the Wrotham Pinot clone of Pinot Noir – including the establishment of two Wrotham Pinot Noir vineyards, one in Napa Valley and the other in Santa Lucia Highlands.

**TASTING NOTES:**

“The 2021 Pinot Noir is bright, punchy and super-expressive. As always, Richard Peterson's Pinot is one of the most floral, restrained wines in the Santa Lucia Highlands. There's terrific energy and plenty of verve that give this deceptively mid-weight, nuanced Pinot a good deal of vibrancy. Crushed red berry fruit, kirsch, rose petal, mint, and white pepper linger on the translucent finish.” – *Antonio Galloni, Vinous*
