DESCRIPTION:

The Glendalough Distillery was set up by a group of friends from Wicklow and Dublin with a passion for reviving the heritage of craft distilling in Ireland. After many evenings of banter and debate over why there weren't more craft distilleries in the birthplace of distilling, the friends convinced each other to leave the safety of their day jobs and head into the mountains to take a chance on something more meaningful. Together they built a craft distillery near their favorite spot in those mountains, Glendalough.

The Johnnie Walker 18-Year-Old (or "Aged 18 Years") is a terrific blended Scotch whisky from the world-famous range, which features a combination of up to 18 different whiskies, including the likes of Cardhu, Glen Elgin, Auchroisk, and Blair Athol, among others. Carefully created by master blender Jim Beveridge.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Amber

Aroma: Creamy notes of buttercream and sweet honey

Palate: Medium-bodied, and very smooth, butterscotch notes

Finish: Beautiful balance, a touch sweet with just a note of smoke
