DESCRIPTION:

Kaiyo Whisky is very intriguing, starting as a teaspooned malt. This means the bulk of the malt whisky comes from one distillery, along with a drop of malt whisky from another distillery, so it can't be called a single malt. The Sheri 3rd Edition release is one of the most rare and limited-produced expressions from Kaiyo. Only 500 cases were produced.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Deep concentrated amber color

Aromas: Very aromatic and rich, notes of cocoa powder, sweet tobacco, very expressive

Palate: Full-bodied with alluring flavors of dried fruits, and vanilla bean with a note of citrus

Finish: Very elegant and smooth, well balanced with a very expressive finish
