Rozelieures Distillery is a family-owned business that has been producing whiskey since 2007 using locally sourced ingredients and traditional distillation methods.

Aromas: Floral, with a delicate touch of peat & smoke

Palate: Layers of fresh orchard fruits (pear) with a note of vanilla

20z Rozelieures Peated Collection 10z Sweet Vermouth

2 dashes of Angostura Bitters

Garnish with Luxardo Maraschino Cherry

STEPS:

Add the Rozelieures Single Malt, sweet vermouth, and bitters into a mixing glass. Add ice and stir until well chilled. Strain into a coupe glass and garnish with a Luxardo Maraschino Cherry.

DESCRIPTION:

William Cadenhead is a name associated with a famous independent bottler of whisky based in Campbeltown, Scotland. The company was founded in 1842 and is one of the oldest and most respected independent bottlers in the whisky industry. William Cadenhead was a grocer and tea merchant who started the company with his brother-in-law, John Taylor. They began by bottling and selling their own tea blends but soon expanded into the whisky trade. They started buying casks of whisky from distilleries throughout Scotland, and then aging, blending, and bottling the whisky themselves. They have a reputation for selecting only the highest quality casks, and for bottling each whisky at cask strength, without chill-filtering or adding color.

TASTING NOTES:

Aromas: Notes of zesty orange to blood orange, caramel, and brown sugar

Palate: Core fruits (green apple) with notes of dried fruits, and spice (Cinnamon)

Finish: Full-bodied, with notes of citrus pulp, toasted nuts, and a sweet hint of maple

ULTIMATE GOGETAIL: Enjoy this Scotch Neat

Using a 9oz tumbler glass, pour the William Cadenhead Aultmore-Glenlivet Single Malt Scotch into the glass. Sip and enjoy!
