DESCRIPTION:

Crafted in collaboration by master distillers, blenders, and apprentices at the iconic 18th Century Middleton Distillery in Cork, Ireland, Method and Madness is an experimental venture at the micro-distillery. Aged initially in French Limousin and then further aged in bourbon casks, this release epitomizes the brand's mission. The whiskey is profoundly complex, expressing a spectrum of notes from tropical fruits to savory spices and decadent chocolates and pastries. It's an Irish Whiskey experience like no other.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Rich, golden amber hue, radiating warmth

Aromas: Floral and sweet, with notes of toasted malt, cinnamon & nuts

Palate: Medium-bodied, initially sweet, with notes of vanilla and cinnamon rolls

Finish: Full finish concludes with toasted barley notes and hints of bakery pastries

DESCRIPTION:

There was a time when all Irish whiskeys were distilled in copper pot stills from a mixture of malted and unmalted barley. Today, however, most Irish whiskey is column-distilled and focused more on mass distribution instead of quality. Redbreast is a rare survivor of the genre. Redbreast dates back to the early 20th century, when the bonding company Gilbey's of Ireland used the name for Jameson spirit which they matured and bottled. Since the 1990s it has been owned by Jameson's parent company, Irish Distillers Ltd. who stakes claim for almost all of the premium whiskey made in Ireland.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Rich copper and amber hues

Aromas: Dried apricot and sultana with assorted spices and toasted wood

Palate: Rich, fully rounded with fruit and spices, vanilla and a touch of oak

Finish: Satisfyingly long with fruit and spices, giving way to toasted oak & barley
