DESCRIPTION:

Meaning 'the original' in Gaelic, A'bunadh Alba is made in homage to Aberlour's founder, James Fleming. Back in 1879, the Aberlour distiller was the most modern distillery of its time. In 1898, an unfortunate fire destroyed most of the distillery and the whisky in their warehouses. The distillery was rebuilt again using the most modern technology and equipment. It wasn't until 1973 that the distillery increased its production by expanding to four pot stills. Today the distillery is considered one of the most sought after and prestigious Scotch Whiskies.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Amber to chestnut, slightly golden

Aromas: Ripe red apples, with notes of honey and vanilla

Palate: Full-bodied, rich with just the right amount of spice

and citrus

Finish: Slightly sweet in the finish with a great creamy texture

Enjoy this spirit, Neat or slightly chilled

Steps: Neat is the least confusing of cocktail terms. This means a spirit is directly poured into a tumbler glass. A neat cocktail is about 2 ounces and not chilled. If you like your spirit slightly chilled, before adding the spirit, add ice to the glass and swirl it around until the glass is chilled, then add the spirit.

DESCRIPTION:

Am Bùrach, Gaelic for 'the mess', might seem a strange name for a limited edition single malt. That would be if you weren't aware of the story behind this unique bottling; the delicious consequence of an incident in 2014 where two different Kilchoman expressions were mistakenly combined. Only 1,750 cases (6 packs) were distributed worldwide.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Medium deep amber

Aromas: Notes of smoke, with sweet dates, citrus, and herbs

Palate: Red fruits, and sweet with a note of vanilla

Finish: Full-bodied with just the right amount of sweetness
