## Proof and Wood 'Good Day' 21-Year-Old Canadian Whiskey

MASH BILL:

97% Corn, 2.7% Rye, 0.3% Malt

ULTIMATE GOOKTAIL: Canadian Maple Old Fashioned

20z Proof and Wood Good Day 2I yr Old
2 dashes of Angostura bitters
2 tsp maple syrup
I-2 Luxardo Cherries
I slice of orange peel

**Steps:** Add ice to a tumbler glass along with the whiskey, maple syrup, bitters, and maraschino cherries. Using a vegetable peeler or a sharp knife peel off a strip of orange rind. Twist and squeeze the orange rind over the cocktail to express and release the orange oils. Stir and serve.

This blended Canadian Whiskey consists of corn, rye, and malt whiskey that was distilled in 2000 or before and entered into the barrel in 2000. This whiskey was carefully aged for 2I years before being finished in Kentucky barrels that previously contained American rye whiskey.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Medium-deep yellow to gold, almost amber

Aromas: Brown sugar with rye-like spice

Palate: Very flavorful, light caramel, with hints of brown

sugar and vanilla

Finish: Long finish with layers of dried fruits and spice
